






Brodhead Circulation





Trend Data - Visits by Year





Brodhead Computer Use Compared to Wireless Internet Use





Overdrive Use by Year








The library offers tax-supported programming throughout the year, including an interactive visit from the Black Star Drum Line in 2018.


Brodhead Programs by Year and Targeted Age Group




Brodhead Program Attendance by Year and Targeted Age Group




